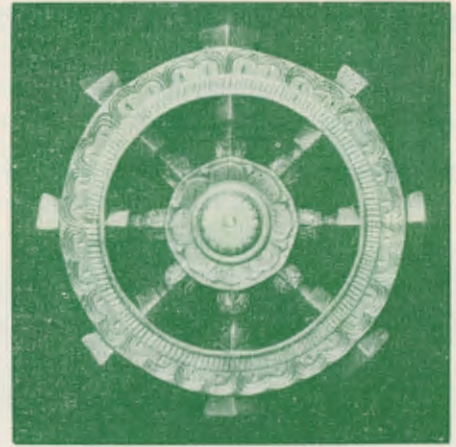

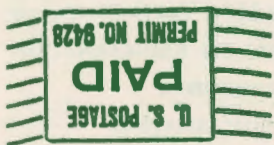

KUAN YIN OF THE ELEVEN LOTUS BLOSSOMS

The original stone carving from which this outstanding example of Chinese art was taken is dated in the Ming Dynasty, 1592 of our chronology. We have been able by a very special process to reproduce the original stone rubbing of this beautiful picture. Kuan Yin, the Buddhist deity of compassion, is represented seated on a balustrade with a pool of lotus blossoms in the foreground. The actual size of the reproduction is 14-1/2 x 20 inches excluding margin. It is printed in a deep slate-blue.
